OUR MISSION

Northern Michigan Horse Rescue & Rehabilitation is a non profit organization formed to provide a program of horse rescue and rehabilitation for physically or psychologically abused, neglected, troubled, abandoned or surrendered equines by providing medical care, rehabilitation and retraining within an environment of physical well-being and trust. In support of these efforts Northern Michigan Horse Rescue & Rehabilitation will employ and promote humane training methods as well as behavioral correction. We are a volunteer organization that is dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation, and placement of unwanted, neglected and abused equines in Michigan. We do this by accepting unwanted horses from individuals, purchasing horses from auctions and by assisting law enforcement by means of providing a safe haven for the horse until further notice. We accept cruelty, neglect and seizure cases and donated horses from individuals who can no longer properly care for their horse, with the exception of stallions and wild Mustangs.

WHAT HAPPENS

We have selected Gaylord Equestrian Center to board these horses with. It is an outstanding facility, with knowledgeable, experienced staff and a professional horse trainer/riding instructor. For more information on Gaylord Equestrian Center, please visit www.gaylordequestriancenter.com.

Once a horse has arrived they will receive any necessary vet and farrier care and be placed under evaluation. After evaluation, those horses that are ready are put up for adoption. Those that need continued extra care, whether it be training, weight gain or just lots of TLC and patience to help them overcome any fears they may have, will enter a program of rehabilitation.

We specialize in matching horses with their ideal human. When a horse is ready we will offer them up for adoption to the general public and will only place these horses in an environment that benefits both the horse and adoptive family. This includes educating adopters, if necessary, in basic horse care and assisting them in finding veterinary and farrier care.

EDUCATION

As part of our program, Northern Michigan Horse Rescue & Rehabilitation will educate potential adopters and the general public as to what is involved to care for a horse properly, including the financial obligations this entails. We will also educate the community about what constitutes horse abuse and neglect, how to recognize and report abuse, how to obtain help and to promote the use of vaccinations and coggins testing.

FUNDING

Our efforts are funded by donations from the general public, sponsorships, contributions, fund raisers, adoption placement donations, and grants from grantors that support animal rights. Our rescue and rehabilitation efforts will be conducted by Northern Michigan Horse Rescue & Rehabilitation, its Directors, Officers and Volunteers.

All donations, funds and adoption fees are put back into the rescue organization so we may continue to help horses in need. If you can and would like to help, you will find our wish list and donation form on the opposite side of this flyer.
